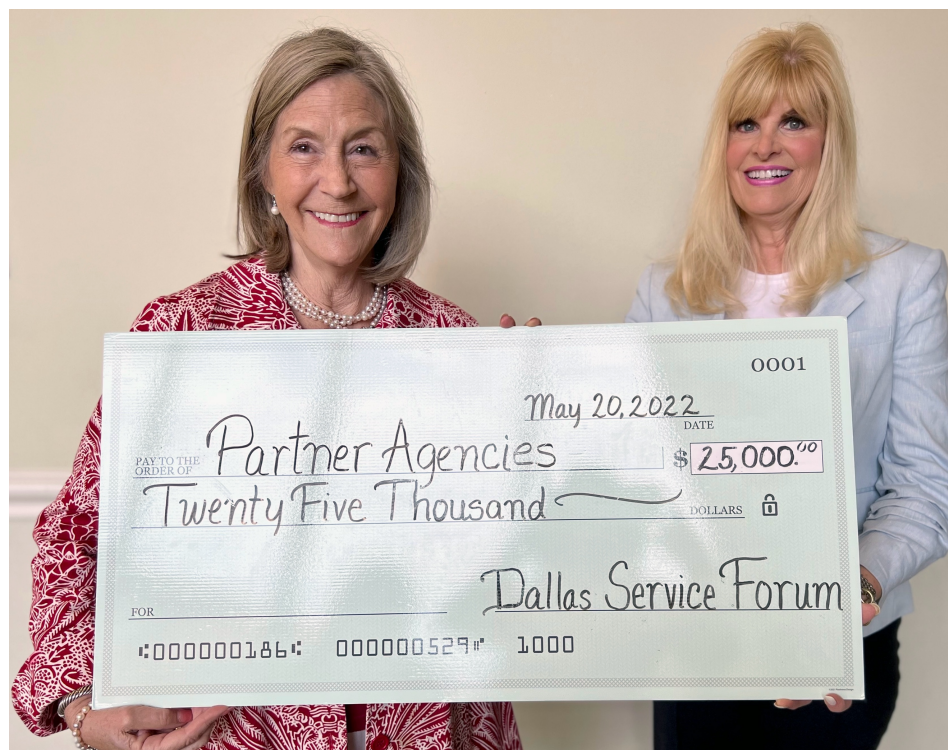

DALLAS SERVICE FORUM HAS ANNOUNCED A \$25,000.00 GIFT TO THEIR NON-PROFIT AGENCY PARTNERS

Dallas Service Forum (formerly Dallas Junior Forum) President Julie Crowley and 2022/23 President Marla Nunally announced an unexpected \$25,000.00 gift has been made to the agency partners supported by DSF.



“Covid continues to take a toll on our agency partners economics and operations, and we are happy and delighted, in the spirit of giving, to make an unexpected funds distribution for their special needs, as we remain committed to our regular giving efforts and programs,” said Crowley.

The recommendation for the \$25,000 gift distribution was approved by the DSF membership at their May meeting and made available from member’s generosity and by funds that were originally ear-marked for a cancelled expense. Agencies were invited to submit their special requests for consideration and allocation was

made by the DSF Board. Agencies receiving funds included Dallas Children's Advocacy Center, Ebby House, The Family Place, Hope's Door New Beginning Center, Juliette Fowler Communities, Network of Community Ministries and Ronald McDonald House of Dallas.

"These agency partners are dedicated to helping others face-to-face, day after day, delivering vital services, and our support for them underscores the DSF mission of providing volunteer services and financial support to children, families, and the elderly throughout the greater Dallas community. Nothing could make us happier than being able to provide this unexpected gift," said Nunally.
