DALLAS SERVICE FORUM CONTINUES TO PROVIDE VOLUNTEER SERVICES AND SUPPORT FOR RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE OF DALLAS

Founded in 1977, Dallas Service Forum is an all-volunteer non-profit women's organization providing volunteer services focused on children families, and the elderly to non-profit agencies in the greater Dallas community. Since 1988, only a few years after Ronald McDonald House of Dallas opened its doors in 1981, DSF has been dedicated to supporting RMD as they provide a "home-away-from-home" and supporting services to families with seriously ill children.

When DSF cooking teams began their volunteer work in the original RMD 37 years ago, it was located near the former St. Paul Hospital, and there was only a residential kitchen in the house. Team members had to purchase, prep and often prepare meals in their own homes, and deliver the meals to the house, where they served the meals to residents. When the house moved to its current location with a commercial kitchen, DSF cooking teams also made the move, and continue, to this day, a commitment to RMD. Currently DSF funds, prepares and serves over 350 meals each month for the RMD residents. Additionally, DSF volunteers assist with RMD'S annual fundraising event, The Trains at NorthPark, as well as support various special events.
